The restaurant, which opened in 2018, is decorated in authentic period items and decor, combined with hand crafted wooden tables made from estate milled Horse-Chestnut.

The views over the tree-lined lochan through the curtain wall of windows provides an airy and bright atmosphere.

The Lairds Table is designed to cater for large or small parties. Our unique window screens are used in the restaurant to provide smaller parties, but can cater for larger parties.

Seated dining can be up to 90 people, whilst standing buffets up to 110.

The restaurant is available every weekday, but dependent on size or party, may be restricted times.

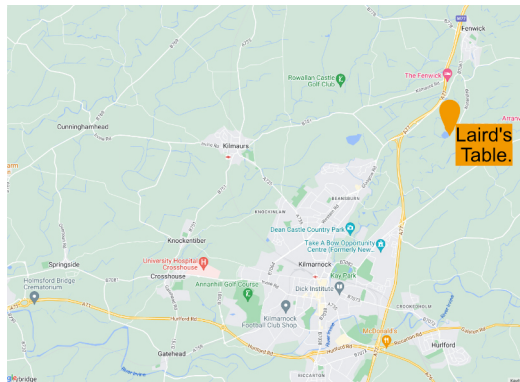
1 - 30 guests	12 noon onward

Castle Funerals

Craufurdland Castle can also be used for funeral teas and small services. The hall can be used for services, for 40 seated, or up-to 100 mixed seated and standing. Funeral teas can be in the hall and the library with a maximum of 50.
